Educational Advisement Services

Partnership educational advisors are available toll-free for individual confidential advisement in the areas of educational planning, alternative approaches to further education, educational financing, career advisement, and adult education basics.

Partnership advisors can work with CSEA-represented NYS employees in the following areas:

- **Academic Advisement** – Helps employees clarify and realize their academic and career goals
- **Adult Education Basics** – Offers advice and referrals to employees who want to: improve reading, writing, and arithmetic skills; obtain a high school diploma; enhance college preparatory skills; and improve their English speaking or understanding skills
- **Career Advisement** – Assists employees in learning about themselves, job choices, and careers
- **Financial Aid** – Provides information about various financial aid programs, federal educational tax credits, and scholarship searches
- **Tuition Benefits Program** – Provides information on how to use vouchers, reimbursement, credit-by-examination fee reimbursement, and other programs
- **Webinars** – Provides instruction on educational and career-related topics
