# Math Refresher 1

**Online Course** 

Requirement: Participants must commit to attend all classes.

This course is free and open to CSEA-represented NYS employees. Other CSEA-represented employees may enroll as space permits. This six-week course is a refresher of basic math topics such as whole numbers, fractions, algebraic expressions, and word problems. Participants will also examine small datasets for mean, median, and mode, and interpret simple graphs.

By the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- Perform basic math calculations with whole numbers and fractions.
- Round values to simplify mental calculations and estimate a value.
- Use the order of operations to solve word problems and algebraic expressions.
- Calculate the mean, median, and mode of a small dataset.
- Interpret bar graphs and pie charts.

Students can request extra help by appointment.
